MATERIALISTIC KNOWLEDGE V/S SPIRITUAL KNOWLEDGE

They will struggle with Modern Maths, which their children have to learn, etc. but, it will seldom occur to them to teach their children Gujarati or at least coach them during their vacation in the same, so they can pray properly and read about our religion. They seldom take children to religious lectures and classes or to visit often Iranshah, Atashbehram, Agiary, etc. The slavish mentality has made us such ardent devotees of Western Concepts, that we are driven away from peace and purity; materialistic knowledge is the speciality of

the Western World.

Spiritual knowledge makes a man humble. Whereas, materialistic knowledge develops Egoism in him. As man progresses and enters deeper and deeper into the folds of spiritual knowledge, he acquires realization in the true sense of the term, of his smallness, his limitations in the vast expanse of Nature and its bounty.

Materialistic Knowledge is of no use or help whatsoever, when our time comes to bid adieu to this world and meet our Maker. On the contrary, according to our Zarathushti Din, this kind of knowledge instead of giving any comfort, makes our soul tied down to worldly things rather then to heavenly ones. Spiritual knowledge, on the other hand is able to conquer the evil that is within us and that which is without, and can procure for us the solace of beholding the gates of heaven rather than the abyss of hell

Our community is not going to step out of the rut it has fallen into till every parent, every mobed and Dastur, every well-wisher and 'Akabar' of the community starts giving his or her true and proper attention and encouragement in advocating the cause of spiritual knowledge as much as they to-day give for the acquisition of materialistic knowledge.
